In February 2019 Pope Francis and the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar, Ahmed el-Tayeb, signed a Document on Human Fraternity for World Peace and Living Together, during a Global Conference on the topic in Abu Dhabi. An organisation, *The Higher Committee of Human Fraternity*, was set up to implement this document. This day of prayer was proposed by this committee, inviting everyone, regardless of religion to participate. This is the first time in history that all religions are being brought together in prayer. The Holy Father invites us all to participate in this historical event.
