THE SECOND COLLECTION TODAY is for LEPRA. Over 7 million people are currently affected by leprosy across the world. Evidence shows over 3 million people are living with undiagnosed leprosy and over 4 million people are living with a life-changing disability caused by leprosy. Although curable, many people are unable to access treatment, even though the cure is free. LEPRA works to find, treat and rehabilitate these hidden people and promote their rights in India, Bangladesh and Zimbabwe.

Please note, it is very important to give the full address of the place of baptism of your child. After your child has been confirmed, our parish secretary will need to write to the parish priest so that he can enter this information into your child's Baptism Register.

The Programme of Preparation includes two meetings for parents at St Michael's Church after the 11:30 Sunday Masses. The first takes place immediately after the Enrolment Mass **NEXT Sunday**, **18th September**. **St Michael's**, 173 Coalway Road, Penn, WV3 7ND.

The second meeting takes place on **Sunday November 6th**. Please be aware that attendance of parents at these two meetings is necessary if you want your child to be confirmed this year.

Once you have filled in your child's Registration Form, *please bring it with you to the Enrolment Mass next Sunday* 18th September.

The Meetings are called '**Journey in Faith**' and they are not only for those interested in becoming Catholics but also for any parishioners who are interested in deepening their faith Next week we will publish the schedule of subjects over the weeks till next Easter. If you are interested in certain topics, you can then come along for those sessions.

<u>MOVING FORWARD WITH THE SYNODAL PATH</u> We have been trying to keep the momentum by organising some of the events that were asked for in the Synodal Path Meetings. For example: the Alpha Course which ran over the summer and the Retreat Day in August.

We are now pressing forward with meetings for those interested in other areas of parish life. So, on **Saturday 1st October** 11.30 in St Michael's Hall there is a meeting to help plan a programme of opportunities for bible study or similar activity throughout the coming year, which will help participants learn more about our faith. One example is the invitation for all parishioners to attend the *Journey in Faith* course.

Then on **Saturday 8th October** 2.30 St Bernadette's Hall there will be meeting to help plan a process for developing a Parish Register of Skills so that more people have opportunities to contribute and participate in parish life. We still need to look at **Youth Provision** and we have been offered some training from the diocese for anyone who could help us with Youth Activities.
