<u>The Coronavirus infection rate is now very High in Wolverhampton</u> The Wolverhampton Director of Public Health has written to us this weekend asking us to be particularly vigilant. It is really important not to mix in groups outside after Mass. This is really hard for us, as it is second nature to do so. It is essential, however if we wish to avoid another lockdown. *Please just wave at your friends and then ring them when you get home!*

<u>Ventilation in Church</u> We are required to ensure that there is plenty of ventilation during Mass. Neither St Michael's nor SS Peter & Paul's have windows which means we need to keep some doors open. **Both churches will be cold, so it is essential that you wear warm clothing for Mass.**

<u>Baptisms</u> We will soon have a Church Cleaning system that will enable us to open the churches for baptisms. These will have to be at fixed times and only one child to be baptised in any service. Baptisms will be at 12.30pm on Saturdays either at SS Peter & Paul or St Michael's. (please note this is different from what was stated last week because of another issue that has arisen) We will be able to start taking bookings from October onwards. Before your child can be baptised it is necessary to attend a Baptism Preparation Class. This will be done however, online my Microsoft Teams.
