VERY IMPORTANT NEWS FOR SS PETER & PAUL CHURCH NEXT SUNDAY 21st AUGUST! you will not be able to access our car park by car!! We have arranged for the Civic Centre car park to be open on the Sunday morning. Any parishioners who wish to park can park here for free. Access will be via Wulfruna Street and you will need to take a ticket from the machine upon entry. When you return to the car park after Mass you will need to go to the little car park office on the ground floor and inform them you were attending Mass and then the staff will validate their ticket and then this will give you free exit out of the car park.

Blue badge parking will be available in the bays on Wulfruna Street and anyone coming by taxi needs to be dropped off by St. Peter's car park.

FIRST MASSES OR THANKSGIVING MASSES OF FR TOBY DUCKWORTH IN THE PARISH

As some of you know, Fr Toby used to be the Pastoral Assistant at SS Peter & Paul in the year before the amalgamation of the parishes and was present at our first joint parish meeting. Since then, he has spent 6 years training for the priesthood at the Venerable English College in Rome. Toby will be visiting the parish next weekend of August 20-21st and will celebrate the 5.30pm and 10.15 am Masses. After these Masses you will be able to queue up to receive a First Blessing from the new priest. Fr Toby will also make a brief appearance before the 9.00am Mass at St Bernadettes and give a general first Blessing and will be available to give First Blessings after the 11.30am Mass at St Michael's. (When a priest celebrates his First Mass after ordination, it is an opportunity for the faithful in attendance to gain a plenary indulgence if all the usual conditions are met. Holy Mother Church updated this tradition by granting a plenary indulgence to all first Masses the priest celebrates. The additional first Masses are sometimes called Masses of Thanksgiving.)
