Please note you MUST book for any of the Masses or Services in HOLY WEEK.

At St Michael's, if you have been asking Sr Lydwin to automatically book you for a Sunday Mass, *this is not possible for over this period.* Each Mass or service, whether on Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday (including Stations of the Cross), the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday, *needs to be booked individually.*

We would like anyone who wants to attend an Easter Mass to be able to do so. Please remember that every Mass in the Easter Week is an Easter Mass. Please do not book for more than one of the Easter Week Masses so that others may be able to attend. The Easter Week Masses are as follows:

Easter Monday: St Michael 6.30pm Easter Tuesday: SS Peter & Paul 9.30am

Easter Wednesday: SS Peter & Paul 9.30am, St Bernadette Midday.

Easter Thursday: St Michael Midday.

Easter Friday: St Bernadette 9.30am SS Peter & Paul Midday.

<u>Solemnity of St Joseph</u> This year, the solemnity of St Joseph on the 19<sup>th</sup> March will be especially significant as we are in the Year of St Joseph. To help prepare for this day we are encouraged to pray the Novena to St Joseph, starting on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> March until Thursday the 18th. Fr Sean will be praying the novena each morning at 8am on the live stream. You are welcome to join live or to pray along later in the day.

<u>Making Connections in LENT</u>: During lent, if your phone number is on the parish database, a registered parish volunteer will ring you to check if your details are correct and if you would like to have someone ring you occasionally to see that you are ok. The plan is to build up a parish network of occasional phone calls, so that no one is missed out in our parish community. All the volunteers who will be doing the ringing have completed the Safeguarding Parish Volunteer Registration Form.

Confessions will be available both at St Michael's and SS Peter and Paul next Saturday at 11.00am.

Stations of the Cross are at St Bernadette's every Thursday at 10.00am St Michael's Church every Friday at 6.30pm

<u>Carmelite Easter Cards</u> will be on sale at weekend Masses throughout Lent: at St Michael's (in the hall BEFORE Mass); at St Bernadette's (in the porch AFTER Mass) and at SS Peter &Paul (outside church AFTER Mass). Large cards will be priced at £1 and a pack of 5 small cards of the SAME design at £2.50. Please have the correct money with you! Thank you for supporting the work of our Carmelite community.

<u>First Holy Communion</u> The children who would have made their First Holy Communion last year will be invited in small groups of three or four to make their First Holy Communion at Sunday Masses. We will make a decision as to when to begin after we see how the infection rate fairs once the schools re-open. If you have a child in Year 3 in a non-Catholic School, they are due to make their First Holy Communion this year.
