Advent Preparations at Home An ideal way to prepare your home for the true spirit of Christmas is to gather in your bubble and celebrate the Advent Feast. Some of you experienced this in the hall at St Michael's last year but it is intended that this is something done at home. The Keralan Community of the Black Country Area Now that St Teresa's Church has been closed, the Archbishop has asked St Michael's Church to host their regular Syro-Malabar Rite Mass. Once public Masses resume, therefore, their Mass will be at 2.30pm on Sunday afternoons. Their Mass will be celebrated by their own chaplain.

<u>Christmas Masses</u> At the moment, we are assuming that we will have public Masses again in time for Christmas. We are putting on extra Masses on Christmas Eve but please be aware that any of the Masses from Christmas Day until New Year's Day are part of what is called the Octave of Christmas and are therefore Christmas Masses. If you are uncertain about gathering in larger crowds, you may consider coming for one of the Christmas Octave Masses.

All Masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day are only available to people who have already booked a place. Booking will start on the week beginning Monday 22nd November. It is essential that you book and let friends and family know that this is the case.
