<u>The Coronavirus infection rate is now very high in Wolverhampton</u> It is *really important* not to mix in groups outside after Mass. Please remember it is against the law to meet people outside of your bubble even in our car parks! This is really hard for us, as it is second nature to do so. It is essential, however if we wish to avoid another lockdown. *Please just wave at your friends and then ring them when you get home!* 

<u>Ventilation in Church</u> We are required to ensure that there is plenty of ventilation during Mass. Neither St Michael's nor SS Peter & Paul's have windows which means we need to keep some doors open. **Both churches will be cold, so it is essential that you wear warm clothing for Mass.** 

**Baptisms** Obviously there is great uncertainty about what will happen over the next few weeks. We are still booking Baptisms at the moment, however, and we will just have to see what happens. If they do take place they will be on Saturday's at 12.30pm either at SS Peter & Paul or St Michael's.

<u>Parish Database</u> During the lockdown in April we tried to ring everyone on our database. Many phone numbers were incorrect and many parishioners are not on the database. As we face the prospect of further restrictions it is important that we have your correct details. *Please do not assume we have your details.* Next week we will be looking into a system of gathering correct information.
