# **FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT (A)**

We are living in an unprecedented time where sadly it will not be possible to celebrate public Mass and it will be a challenge to keep the lines of communication open across the parish. Please therefore think of any neighbours you know who might not have access to the internet and print off a copy of this bulletin and post it through their letter box. Most of all, let us pray for each other whenever possible.

<u>Mass online</u> As it is not possible for us to celebrate public Mass together, Fr Mark will be celebrating Mass in the side chapel at SS Peter & Paul. This will be available on the website each day at the times listed on this bulletin. Those Mass intentions that would have been on Sunday Masses will be celebrated on the nearest weekdays. You can participate in these Masses by following the link on the website. For those of you who do not have the internet, it would be lovely if you could pray the Rosary at the time of these Masses.

**Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion** Sadly it will not be possible for you to take Holy Communion to the sick. Please keep in touch with those you normally visit by telephone and pray with them over the phone.

**Volunteering** Might you be able help in some way? Some examples are: keeping touch with people by phone, doing shopping for those who are isolated, being on a rota to open your church for prayer or being on a rota to clean the church. If you are interested in any of these and any other ideas you may have, please follow the directions on our website.

**Spiritual Communion** As it is not possible to receive Holy Communion at this time, it is important to remember the tradition of Spiritual Communion. This is a special prayer to recite at the moment of Holy Communion in the Mass. An example of this prayer is as follows:

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.

<u>Church opening times</u> This week we will be organising rotas so that the Churches can be open for part of the day for private prayer. It is important, however, that people *only come into the church for private prayer* and do not use it as a place to gather and meet with others. Please remember to keep at least six feet away from others to avoid infection. If you want to socialise please use the telephone. If we do not follow these guidelines, Public Health will demand that we close the churches.

The times for SS Peter and Paul this week will be Wednesday 10.30am- 3.30pm and Friday 10.30am to 2.30pm. During this week we will sort out times for St Bernadette's and St Michael's.

<u>We will also be leaving the porch of St Michael's open</u> so that people can still drop off food donations for Outreach4Wolverhampton, the Good Shepherd Ministry and Life. We have chosen this place as it is in the middle of the three churches and has a large porch. Once we have a rota organised we will advertise times when you can drop things off.

<u>Laetare Sunday:</u> Mothering Sunday, 22nd March, a National Day of Prayer and Action. At 7pm this Sunday, place a light or a candle in the windows of your homes as a visible symbol of the light of life, Jesus Christ, our source and hope in prayer. A pink candle would be appropriate but any candle will do.

<u>Support the homeless</u> via *Outreach4Wolverhampton*. A basket will be in the porch at St Michael's. The O4W volunteers would appreciate donations of: coffee; sugar; long life milk; crisps; chocolate; biscuits; hats; gloves; socks; underwear (men - small boxer shorts, ladies - pants, size 8/10/12); roll on deodorants and wet wipes. Thank you!

<u>Life Charity Shop at 12 Lichfield Street</u>: For the present, the shop remains open. We are very grateful for all parishioners' past donations which have helped its success, We hope your help will continue at this difficult time. If you cannot take your donated goods to the shop, or leave them in the usual box when the church is open, please contact Rosalie on 330553 to arrange collection, or delivery to my house. Thank you.
