The more we get to know these characters and their stories, the more we will come to know Jesus Christ. They will be blessed at Mass this weekend and then will be put up around the Church this week for the year ahead.

Monday is the 75th anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz and it is also Holocaust

Memorial Day. In cities and towns across the United Kingdom, events will be held to mark this milestone in human history and to express the hope that such evil may never happen again. There is a special service at the cenotaph in Wolverhampton at 11.00am. *Our Timeline of the Hebrew Scriptures around the church will remind us that the most sacred texts in Judaism are also most sacred to us.* The Catholic Church, therefore, condemns all forms of anti-semitism.
