FOOD FOR THOUGHT In 2011, the Catholic bishops of England and Wales called on congregations to return to foregoing meat on Fridays. Only around a quarter of Catholics changed their dietary habits – yet this still saved over 55,000 tonnes of carbon a year, according to a new study led by the University of Cambridge!

Researchers say that, in terms of CO2 emissions, this is equivalent to 82,000 fewer people taking a return trip from London to New York over the course of a year.

As Advent begins next week, a time of new beginnings, why not take up the call to refrain from meat on Fridays? As a penitential act, it is a way of uniting ourselves with Christ on the day of his passion and uniting ourselves with Christ in the poor who cannot afford meat, and as a small act of Living Simply to help reduce carbon emissions for the sake of the planet.
