### Parish News and Activities

Confessions now take place in the Sacristy each Saturday Morning at St Michaels from 11.00 - 11.30am

The Feast Day of St Michael and Prayers for Vocations If it were not for the coronavirus regulations, next Tuesday would have been a day of prayer for vocations with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament all day in St Michael's, probably followed by a party! Instead, however, there will be a special online Mass prepared by St Michael's School at 2.00 pm and then at 5.00 pm there will be a special *Online Holy Hour for Vocations*.

Reopening of St Bernadette's Next Sunday, the 9.00am Mass will restart. This is thanks to yet another great team of volunteers who will be stewarding and cleaning the church. We are meeting to mark out the church and put up notices etc this Monday at 12.00 midday. Any volunteers are welcome.

Online Classes for those interested in becoming Catholics Starting Thursday 1st October. We welcome him into our parish community.

<u>The Coronavirus infection rate is now very high in Wolverhampton</u> It is *really important* not to mix in groups outside after Mass. Please remember it is against the law to meet people outside of your bubble even in our car parks! This is really hard for us, as it is second nature to do so. It is essential, however if we wish to avoid another lockdown. *Please just wave at your friends and then ring them when you get home!* 

Track and Trace On Thursday night we discovered that someone who was at Mass at SS Peter & Paul last Sunday had become ill and tested positive for coronavirus. As they became ill more than 48 hours after the Mass, we were advised by the Director of Public Health that we did not need to contact Track and Trace but ask everyone who had attended that Mass to be more vigilant. If this person had become ill sooner, we would have had to contact Track and Trace, which explains why it is so important that we have the contact details of everyone who comes to Mass. This weekend we will also be displaying Official NHS Track & Trace posters. These can be scanned using the Track & Trace App on your mobile phone. A video explaining how to use these will be uploaded to the parish website. The health of the person who has tested for coronavirus is improving greatly but will be grateful of your prayers.

<u>Ventilation in Church</u> We are required to ensure that there is plenty of ventilation during Mass. Neither St Michael's nor SS Peter & Paul's have windows which means we need to keep some doors open. **Both churches will be cold, so it is essential that you wear warm clothing for Mass.** 

<u>Baptisms</u> Unfortunately, I have received no clarity from the Bishops' Conference yet about numbers allowed at Baptism Celebrations. It may be that only 6 guests are allowed under the new government regulations. As soon as I know, I will contact families who have already made bookings. Baptisms are celebrated on Saturdays at 12.30pm either at SS Peter & Paul or St Michael's.

<u>Stewards for Baptisms</u> If we are able to have more than 6 guests at baptisms, we will need stewards. Is anyone able to help on Saturday mornings in either SS Peter & Paul or St Michael's? It would be great if we had new volunteers, rather than stewards who are already helping at Mass.

<u>Parish Database</u> During the lockdown in April we tried to ring everyone on our database. Many phone numbers were incorrect and many parishioners are not on the database. As we face the prospect of further restrictions it is important that we have your correct details. *Please do not assume we have your details.* To begin the process of correcting our database, if you are on email, please email us with your correct address and telephone numbers.
