

If you have access to the internet, please also join us on **Good Friday** and **Holy Saturday mornings at 10.00am** for the Office of Readings. This is a simple and ancient service of psalms and readings designed to

help us mediate on the events of these two days. You can download the texts for these services from the "Watch Live" page of the parish website.

This last year has been a difficult time for everyone, let us pray during this week that if we unite our sufferings with Jesus, he may transform these experiences into opportunities for healing and new life. Let us also pray for all those for whom faith is a real struggle, that by the grace of God, they may find new hope in the message of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ.
