- 2. For the time being there will be no Holy Water in the porch. If you wish to have Holy Water, please bring an empty bottle for the priest to bless.
- 3. At the sign of peace, we will bow to each other, rather than shaking hands.
- 4. For the time being, Holy Communion will only be administered under one kind.
- 5. Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are to wash their hands with soap before Mass and then when they come up to give Holy Communion, they are to sanitise their hands with the sanitiser on the Credence Table.
