<u>DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY</u> This Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. Jesus said to St Faustina: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy... I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy...Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

After Mass, therefore, at SS Peter and Paul on this Sunday there will be a special prayer service in honour of the Divine Mercy, followed by the opportunity for confessions.
