STATEMENT FROM INTERFAITH WOLVERHAMPTON 8TH AUGUST 2024

At this time when the streets of many cities have been plagued by violence, faith leaders in Wolverhampton have come together to remind people that what makes someone a “Wulfrunian” is not their heritage, race or religion. Instead, it is the desire to call Wolverhampton “home”, to live in peace and to work for the good of the city we all share. Over generations, people from many parts of the world have settled in Wolverhampton, bringing with them different expressions of faith and culture and together building a city of rich diversity. The people of Wolverhampton are consistent living examples of what it looks like to live together well despite differences that could set us apart. Our different faiths hold in common a commitment to being a good neighbour to one another, and especially to the stranger in our midst who seeks sanctuary – values also shared by those of no faith. We are proud of Wolverhampton’s status as a City of Sanctuary. Along with all the partners with whom we are working, we call upon the people of Wolverhampton to continue to demonstrate that differences do not have to cause divisions between us, and that together we are stronger than the forces that may seek to divide us.
