BLESSED CARLO CANONISATION PREPARATIONS The next Blessed Carlo Intentions Mass will be at SS Peter & Paul on Friday 20th September at 12.30pm. Please remember to place your prayer intentions in the boxes in each church and these will be laid on the altar at that Mass. We then have our Parish Feast Day Celebrations the weekend of 12/13 October. There will be a special Mass for the anointing of the sick on the Saturday, and there will be a parish party at 1.00pm on the Sunday. If you have any ideas about how we can celebrate our patron at that party, please contact Fr Mark. This will be the last celebration before Blessed Carlo is Canonised next year. (The Vatican have not confirmed the date yet.) We also need to be thinking about how we will celebrate his Canonisation!
