We are frequently asked to help needy families and your generosity makes a real difference to the care of babies and toddlers. This Helpline also offers a confidential listening ear to anyone who is worried about a pregnancy related issue, or who has experienced loss of a pregnancy.

<u>Crisp-packet recycling.</u> This scheme suggested by our young people at St Michael's has returned: notices will remind you to sanitise if you touch the bin with your hands, as you do with other items at church. Most people bring packets which have had a few days' "rest" at home to help mitigate any risk attached to them of spreading disease: thank you for your thoughtfulness.

<u>The Food</u> continues at our three churches after all Masses and outside St Michael's Tuesday 1-2 and Saturday 10-11. Donations of food and toiletries; unwrapped toys and selection boxes; hot water bottles and blankets are gratefully accepted. Thank you! This week's donations have been distributed via a free pop up shop at St Patrick's Catholic Primary Academy. The £500 grant from four local Rotary Clubs and The James Beattie Charitable Trust has been converted into supermarket vouchers and given to five city primary schools, in good time for Christmas. Again a huge thank you to them!
