**PARISH PILGRIMAGE TO ROME AND ASSISI** When the price came in for the October dates it was far too expensive, so we will now be travelling from *Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November to Sunday 10th November*. # NOTES FROM PASTORAL COUNCIL NOVEMBER 2023

- Celebration of Feast of Blessed Carlo Acutis Many thanks were expressed to all those who worked so hard to arrange the various activities making the event a joyous and successful one.
- Christmas Fayre It was decided that two thirds of the profit would go to the parish and one third to the charity 'Friends of the Holy Land'.
- One Christmas Raffle across the whole parish will be the norm from now on.
- **Parish Fayres** In order to make more time between the Wombourne Autumn Fayre and the Penn Christmas Fayre there will be a 5 week gap between them next year, and hopefully a greater gap in the following year.
- Communion in both kinds There have been requests that we return to offering the Chalice at Sunday Masses. There is
  some hesitation among parishioners that it is too early, with covid still being at large. It was decided that we look at
  reintroducing the Chalice at Easter, and in the meantime, ask parishioners to make comment in the new year.
- **Hand Rails** We are looking into the possibility of hand rails up to the Sanctuary in St Michaels; and also the possibility of enlarging the kitchen in St Michael's hall and some refurbishment in St Michael's Church.
- **Hymn Books** Another parish is kindly donating hymn books to St Michael's church, as many there are in a state of disrepair.
- New Suggestion Forms need to be reprinted for each of the Churches.
- **Support for Bereaved Families** It has been proposed that next year the November Mass for recently bereaved should be followed by refreshments.
- Angelus For this year's Advent, it was suggested that all the Masses will start with the Angelus.
- **Sunday Reflections** The reflections on the readings sheet at St Michael and St Bernadette will also be made available at SS Peter & Paul.
- Youth Group It is hoped that this may be able to start on Friday evenings in the New Year.
