New Policy for Baptism of Infants It is a wonderful thing to desire to have your child baptised. If you ask to have your child baptised in the Catholic Church you are taking on a serious commitment. By asking to have your child baptised, you are indicating that you wish to come to Mass every Sunday and bring your child up according to the teachings of the Catholic Church. If this is what you seek, then please speak to one of the priests after a Sunday Mass and ask to fill in a **Baptism Enquiry Form**. He will then arrange to visit you to explain the procedure leading up to the Baptism of your Child. After a month you will be asked to meet with the priest again to fill in the **Baptism Registration Form**. Before the Baptism takes place, you will be asked to attend a Baptism Preparation Class which normally takes place on a Saturday.
