people are very afraid of being caught up in random gun fire; there was no electricity for 14 days many babies on breathing equipment and people on kidney machines sadly died; doctors are afraid of being attacked; food and medicine supplies are very low; food prices have rocketed with many people being unable to buy enough food for their families. Your generosity has helped raise £2,250 through the Marsden Singers concert at SS Peter & Paul, sunflower sales, 2 CWL events, donations and the Maundy Thursday collection. We receive £350 through standing orders on a monthly basis.
