TODAY IS THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI After both the 10.15 am Mass at SS Peter & Paul and the 11.30 am Mass at St Michael's, we will be having Corpus Christi processions and those who have made their First Holy Communion recently are warmly invited to process at the front of these processions.

HOLY SHROUD EXHIBITION 20th June – 3rd July We are very blessed to be hosting this exhibition at SS Peter &



Paul's Church. The exhibition features a full-sized replica of the Shroud of Turin (the actual Shroud is housed in the Cathedral of the Italian city of Turin) and includes detailed information boards about aspects of the shroud, together with other exhibits, including a life-sized statue of the Roman centurion who pierced the side of Christ, and replicas of instruments used in His crucifixion. The exhibition aims to use the replica of the Shroud as a visual aid to tell the story of the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and to examine the mystery of the cloth. It takes the journey of Jesus from his trial through the events of Good Friday to the empty tomb, using passages from the four gospels. It tries to demonstrate what the flogging, the whip, the piercings, the nails and spear were really like, using the Shroud as a teaching aid. It has both a historical and a spiritual dimension. Visitors are given a chance to gain a deeper understanding of the great sacrifice Christ made for us for our own redemption.

An ideal time for parishioners to come to the Exhibition will be for Vespers* at 7.00pm on Tuesday 20th because afterwards there will be a talk about the Shroud, giving a full explanation of the exhibition.

*Vespers is an old English name for the service of Evening Prayer which is a simple service of psalms and canticles prayed by priest, convents and monasteries every day. It is now encouraged that all people have the opportunity to join in this important prayer of the church when possible.

A typical Alpha evening involves a free meal, a video on one of life's big questions and an open discussion.
