As there is also a missionary appeal, the second collection will take place during the final hymn of Mass and then we will begin the Procession afterwards. NEW DATE FOR CANONISATION OF ST CARLO ACUTIS! It will be SUNDAY 7th September.

This means there will be only ONE Mass the weekend of September 6th -7th

This will be at 9.30am at St Michael's Church and will be celebrated by Bishop Timothy Menezes. Please be seated by 9.00am. There will be a large screen set up in the church and we will watch the declaration of the canonisation in Rome. This lasts about half an hour and then we will start the Entrance Hymn of our Mass. After Mass there will then be a reception for everyone who has come to Mass at St Edmund's Catholic Academy. The Mass will be livestreamed for those who are unable to attend.
