VISIT OF ANTONIA SALZANO, MOTHER OF BLESSED

CARLO ACUTIS I was delighted to be able to get to Corpus Christi Church in Covent Garden on Thursday night to attend Mass and to listen to Blessed Carlo's mother. It was a very warm evening, and the church was heaving with people. There were crowds stood at the back spilling onto the street and people were sitting on the floor at the front of the church as there was no space left in the pews. Antonia gave a very clear and inspiring explanation of Blessed Carlo's message and she also talked about their family life. When she was talking about Blessed Carlo's devotion to the Eucharist, she mentioned the exhibition of Eucharistic miracles that we had displayed in our church a couple of years ago. She also mentioned that the blood type that is found in such cases is the same blood group as found on the Turin Shroud, something you will be able to read more about when the exhibition comes to SS Peter & Paul's Church later this month. At the end of her talk, you will see I was able to speak to her to tell her about our parish and I invited her to come to see us if ever she comes to England again. Let's pray that she does!



HOLY SHROUD EXHIBITION 20th June – 3rd July We are very blessed to be hosting this exhibition at SS Peter &



Paul's Church. The exhibition features a full-sized replica of the Shroud of Turin (the actual Shroud is housed in the Cathedral of the Italian city of Turin) and includes detailed information boards about aspects of the shroud, together with other exhibits, including a life-sized statue of the Roman centurion who pierced the side of Christ, and replicas of instruments used in His crucifixion. The exhibition aims to use the replica of the Shroud as a visual aid to tell the story of the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and to examine the mystery of the cloth. It takes the journey of Jesus from his trial through the events of Good Friday to the empty tomb, using passages from the four gospels. It tries to demonstrate what the flogging, the whip, the piercings, the nails and spear were really like, using the Shroud as a teaching aid. It has both a historical and a spiritual dimension. Visitors are given a chance to gain a deeper understanding of the great sacrifice Christ made for us for our own redemption.
