As we make a fresh beginning after more than a year of lockdowns and restrictions, our aim is for clergy and the lay faithful to work closely to create vibrant communities of faith, joyful in their service of God and neighbour.

The Letter will be accompanied by a prayer card and will also be available in audio and video format via the diocesan website, for which details will be given next week.

Corpus Christi



Today we celebrate the great feast that reminds us of the miracle that takes place at every Mass;

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) teaches that, beginning "at the moment of consecration" (CCC 1377), the bread and wine offered at Mass "become Christ's body and blood" (CCC 1333). This is not a metaphor, a symbol, or a spiritual idea; it really happens. In the Eucharist, "the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained" (CCC 1374). The Eucharist still appears to our senses as ordinary bread and wine; but it has been transubstantiated (or changed in its substance) into the body and blood of Christ. This is why Catholics attending Mass are encouraged to "convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of this moment when Christ becomes our guest" (CCC 1387); it's why we adore the Eucharist, "not only during Mass, but also outside of it" (CCC 1378); and it's why the Church teaches that the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324).
