Action points from the Parish Council Meeting March 15th 2024

- **New Secretary and Chairperson:** Chidi Oliseowe was elected the new Secretary and Cathrine Arthurs was elected the new Chairperson of the council.
- **Safeguarding**: Marie Yeo has joined the Parish Safeguarding team along with Chris and Steve Callow. Marie will assist with any issues relating to SS Peter and Paul and also with the DBS documentation.
- The Welcome Pack for new parishioners is nearly ready and will be presented to the parish shortly.
- **Synodal Way:** the Pastoral Council received the report from the group that met at SS Peter & Paul's in February. The council has set up a working committee to look into the report in May in order to prepare an open Parish Synodal Meeting on October 5th at 2.00pm in St Michael's Hall. Everyone is invited.
- Communion under Both Kinds: A Parish survey will be carried out after Easter and depending on the uptake we will look at how best to organise the distribution of Holy Communion beginning on the Feast of Corpus Christi 2024
- **Livestreaming:** The provision of live streaming services in St Michael's in addition to the Sunday Mass at SSPP was considered. It was decided that a permanent system would not be cost effective, given that the parish already has one in place. A mobile system that could be used in any of the churches for special events is being investigated.
- Stewarding: Mass attendance at SS Peter & Pauls' Church is now so good that there is a need for more stewards so that people can be welcomed gracefully, and seats be found for them whilst maintaining reverence during Mass. An appeal for more stewards will take place after Easter.
- Estates Management: We now have a new agent looking after the parish rental properties, but we are still in the process of finding a new system for the management of our church buildings. Whilst we are in this transition, please direct any matter or points to your Pastoral Council Representatives or Mgr Mark himself.
- **Photographs of Parish Representatives**: Now that most of the council members have changed since the last poster was made, we will shortly be publishing photographs of all the parish representatives in each church porch.
- **Hymn Books at St Michael's**: Extra hymn books were donated from another church, but they are an older version with some hymns missing. As we do not tend to use these hymns, we can use these books for the time being.
- **Retreats**: There was positive feedback from the Lent Retreat Day. We have the Triduum retreat coming up this week and there are some possible day pilgrimages in the pipeline.
