<u>IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE CAR PARK AT SS PETER & PAUL CHURCH</u> The main lower car park from next week will be a <u>Public Car Park</u> whereby you pay with an App on your phone. Anyone parking during the week without paying on the App, will receive a fine.

On Sunday Mornings the System is turned off. The Signposts will say "Authorised User Only" for Sunday mornings. As a parishioner attending Mass, you are the authorised user! So, on Sunday Mornings there is no change from how you park at Mass.

If you attend Mass, or a meeting or whatever in the church during the week, you can park there for free, as long as when you enter the porch of the church you enter your car registration number into the new machine that will be there.

MANY THANKS to Mr Bill Finnegan who started the previous scheme for the Car Park at SS Peter & Paul several decades ago and over the years raised hundreds of thousands of pounds for the parish. Since Covid, working practices changed and not so many companies use the car park in business hours, so we needed to find a new system that could profit from the visitors to the Civic Hall and Molineux. The scheme that Mr Finnegan set up, however, made SS Peter & Paul's viable at a time when the future of SS Peter & Paul's Church was very vulnerable, and our church would not still be here if it were not for the income that he generated. The community at SS Peter & Paul's is indebted to him for his business sense and commitment to the church.

<u>DAY OF PRAYER FOR PEACE, 8 MARCH 2024</u> Cardinal Vincent Nichols has asked for a special focus of prayer on 8 March for peace in the Holy Land. In his message, he writes: "As we are all aware, the situation in the Holy Land has not improved, with failed negotiations, increasing humanitarian distress and a rising death toll. As Lent begins, I would like to urge that we continue our efforts, not least in prayer. And so, I ask that, on Friday 8 March, there is a special focus of prayer for the Holy Land. This could take the form of a dedicated time of prayer, perhaps before the Blessed Sacrament, for peace in the Holy Land. It could be as simple as making any regular Lenten devotions you may be having on that day for this intention. "

TRIDUUM RETREAT We are restarting the tradition that stopped during Lockdown of offering a retreat over the days of the Triduum (Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday). This involves coming to a talk at 10.00am on Maundy Thursday and then taking away some reading for reflection and then attending the Services of Matins on Good Friday and Holy Saturday, as well as attending the main Solemn Services of those three days. *More details will be available next week.*
