The so called 'Slipper Chapel' here was built in 1325. People left their shoes here before walking the last mile on barefoot to the main shrine. The main shrine was destroyed by King Henry VIII at the Reformation. In 1897 the Slipper Chapel was restored to Catholic use and became the English National Shrine to Our Lady.

In 2015 Pope Francis gave the Catholic National Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham in England a rare honour. The shrine – specifically the Slipper Chapel, the Chapel of Reconciliation and the Domain – has been granted minor basilica status.

In his message to mark the day, Pope Francis stresses the need to listen before speaking truth with a pure heart to "see beyond appearances and overcome the vague din which, in the field of information, does not help us discern in the complicated world in which we live." The Holy Father, warning against indifference and indignation, hails the example of the great Doctor of the Church, St Francis de Sales, in particular his commitment to patient, heartfelt dialogue. A gifted theologian, his phrase *'Heart speaks to heart'* inspired many, none more so than Saint John Henry Newman, who chose this same phrase as his motto when he became cardinal.
