This Thursday is the Feast of the Ascension There is a special celebration of Mass in each church to mark this great feast. We then begin the ancient Novena of prayer leading up to Pentecost Sunday. As we are in the month of May, a great way to prepare for Pentecost is to pray the Rosary each day. This year we call upon the Holy Spirit to renew the life of our parish community as we begin to emerge from the coronavirus guidelines.

<u>Confessions at SS Peter & Paul Church</u> Now that the Covid restrictions are beginning to relax, we will once again be available for Confessions after the Midday Friday Masses. There will also be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

**Explore the Meaning of Life with Alpha** Would you (or someone you know) like to explore the big questions of life? Would you like to get to know Jesus with greater intimacy? Are you considering becoming Catholic or Christian? Would you like to help out in some way? If you tick any one of these boxes, then the Alpha Course is for you! It involves sharing a meal together, watching an insightful and engaging video and then having an informal discussion on that week's topic. **Alpha will begin on Monday 17th May**. This will be a great opportunity for renewal in faith and community after what has been a very tough year.

**Non-Catholic School Children Sacramental Preparation** Sacramental preparation for children who go to non-Catholic schools will begin on Saturday June 12<sup>th</sup>. Following this course, the children will be able to make their first reconciliation before the end of the school year and their first Holy Communion in the Autumn. **First Holy Communions** Please remember in your prayers the children who could not receive their First Holy Communion last year. Small groups of two or three children from SS Peter & Paul's School, St Bernadette's School and St Michael's School will me making their First Holy Communion at Sunday Masses over the next few weeks. **These will be normal Sunday Masses and only the children and their parents will be booked into these Masses.** Social distancing will need to be respected afterwards in the car park. We do hope, however, to have a bigger celebration when the restrictions are relaxed.

<u>Praying the Rosary at home in May</u> This weekend we begin the month of May. This is traditionally a time when we turn to Mary our Mother in prayer and particularly with the Holy Rosary. To help us this year, the members of the Knights of St Columba in our parish will lead the Rosary for us each Thursday in May at 8.00pm.
