<u>BAPTISMS</u> We are introducing a new system for registration for children's baptisms. If you would like your child to be baptised, please contact one of the priests after Sunday Mass and he will give you a code so that you can access the **Digital Registration Form**. You will then be contacted about attending the Parents' Baptism Class. At the end of the class, you will be able to organise the date for the baptism. Baptisms normally take place on the first and third Sundays of the month.
