THE NEW LECTIONARIES FOR OUR THREE CHURCHES HAVE NOW ARRIVED. We have bought a Lectionary set for each Church and two Gospel Procession books. (*We can use one Gospel book for St Bernadette's and St Michael's, as the Mass times never clash*). By pre-ordering in May, we were able to secure a 15% discount. So, each set of Lectionaries cost £590.75 and each Gospel Book cost £233.75. The full cost to the parish was therefore £2,239.75. There are now 4 volumes of the Lectionary covering the readings throughout the year. This means each individual volume costs £147.69. The volumes are beautifully presented and will last for decades to come. If any individual or group would like to sponsor one of these volumes for their church, there are special dedication labels that would be fixed inside the front cover.
