There will be a variety of changes that we need to make to comply, most of these will only concern how we run the parish office. One major change that will affect the bulletin, however, is that nobody's name may appear on the bulletin without their consent. Sadly, this will affect the Sick List. From now on, we may only add names to the list if the person named has given his or her consent. This can be verbal consent, but the parish priest must keep a record that the consent has been given. We therefore must start a new list from next week with only people who have given their consent. The old list is being kept in the convent so that all those who were named are still being prayed for in the meantime. Mass intentions also must not indicate if a person is ill unless they have given consent. It will take a while for us all to get used to these changes but please bear with us as we seek to comply with the law of the land.
