WOLVERHAMPTON HALF MARATHON SUNDAY 8th SEPTEMBER Without any consultation, the council have agreed a route with the Marathon organisers that will mean that all access to SS Peter & Paul's Church will be closed off next Sunday! The first we knew about this was an email on August 24th and then a leaflet with the exact route on Monday 26th August! THEREFORE, NEXT SUNDAY THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE CHURCH ALONG PATERNOSTER ROW.

You will need to park in the Civic Centre by travelling along Stafford Street and Wulfruna Street. You will need to pay for your parking and then register that you have done this with one of our church wardens. Then the Marathon organisers will reimburse the parish, and we will be able reimburse you for parking.

Fr Mark has expressed emphatically that the parish should have been consulted earlier and they have promised to do so for next year. We have organised a petition to go to the council, requesting that next year we be involved in the planning of the route.
